Report dated 6.6.2015 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Abohar has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioner Jagdish Chander as well as of complainants Surinder Kumar and Sukhpal it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that being a pure accident case and that parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and to bring about harmonious atmosphere and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.105 dated 15.11.2012 under Sections 304A,279,337,338,427 IPC Police Station, Khuian Sarwar, Tehsil Abohar District Fazilka and all other consequential proceedings arising

therefrom are hereby quashed.

Petition stands disposed off.
