The present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case First Information Report No.154 dated 19.10.2014 registered under Sections 452, 354, 427, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 4 of the Protection of Children against Sexual Offences Act, 2012 at Police Station Division No.5, Jalandhar.

On instructions from ASI Resham Singh, learned State counsel informs that the petitioners, in compliance of the order dated 21.5.2015, have joined the investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation as nothing remains to be recovered from them.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 21.5.2015, vide which the petitioners were allowed interim bail, is made absolute. They shall abide by the conditions as enshrined in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
