Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.545 dated 29.10.2013, under Sections 306, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Asandh, District Karnal.

Following order was passed by this Court on 01.05.2014:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the first suicide note left by the deceased though there was reference of the petitioner, yet it is not stated that the petitioner had abetted the commission of suicide. In the third suicide note, the petitioner is not named at all. However, in the second suicide note, a mention is made that the petitioner and his co-accused had taken a sum of Rs.twenty lakhs from him as loan for three months which they had not returned. It is

submitted that even if the allegations levelled in the second suicide note are taken as such, it would be debatable as to whether they would amount to abetment of commission of suicide.

Adjourned to 5.8.2014.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 8.5.2014 at 11.00 AM for joining the investigation. In the event of his arrest, he shall be released on interim bail by the Investigating/Arresting Officer to his satisfaction. He shall, however, abide by all the conditions, as envisaged by Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Jagmahal Singh has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation. In fact, challan has been presented in the Court and charges have been framed against all the accused.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioner vide order dated 01.05.2014, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
