The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking the benefit of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.124 dated 17.08.2014, under Sections 323/324/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Lambi, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Having argued the matter at some length counsel prays for withdrawal of the instant petition

Counsel raises a further submission that the petitioner would surrender before the Investigating Agency and if thereafter an application for regular bail is filed, directions be issued for the competent Court to decide such application within a time bound frame.

As per prayer made by counsel, the instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

It is, however, observed that in case the petitioner duly surrenders within a period of one week from today and thereafter files an application seeking regular bail, the competent Court would take up such

application for consideration strictly on merits and would make every endeavor to expedite the hearing of the same.
