Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C.
by petitioners No. 2 to 4 for grant of anticipatory bail, in case bearing
FIR No. 190, dated 09.03.2015, under Sections 363, 366-A and 34
IPC, at Police Station City Ballabgarh, District Faridabad.

On the last date of hearing i.e. May 21, 2015, petition qua
petitioner No.1 was dismissed as not pressed, at that stage.

At the very outset of the arguments, learned State
counsel, on instructions from ASI Mohammad Mustakeen, has
submitted that petitioners No. 2 to 4 namely, Prem Singh, Omwati
and Bedan have already been found innocent during investigation of

this case, conducted by ACP Gajinder Singh, Police Station City Ballabgarh, District Faridabad and are no more required for further interrogation.

Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with the direction to the investigating agency that, in case, presence of petitioners No. 2 to 4 is required, at any subsequent stage, they be served with five days' prior notice.
