**M.M.S. BEDI, J (ORAL)**

Petitioners seek concession of pre-arrest bail in a case registered at the instance of Hari Singh alleging that the petitioners connived with other co-accused and hatched a criminal conspiracy by forging a Will of his father Ajit Singh. Petitioner No.1 and the complainant are real brothers.

Learned counsel for the complainant has intervened to oppose application for pre-arrest bail contending that the petitioner No.1 is one of the beneficiaries of the Will and that the father of the complainant namely Ajit Singh was admitted in hospital. He was staying with the complainant but the Will has been got fabricated at a place in Rajasthan. He places reliance on a report of Forensic Science Laboratory, Madhuban where the signatures of Ajit Singh appearing on the Will have been found to be forged.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned counsel for the complainant as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

It has been informed that the petitioners have joined investigation.

Since the dispute regarding the disputed title of the property left by Ajit Singh is subject matter of the civil litigation, petitioners, in said circumstances, cannot be declined concession of pre-arrest bail. It does not appear to be a case of custodial interrogation.

Petition is allowed. It is ordered that in case of arrest of petitioners, they will be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to the condition that they will not tamper with the evidence or hamper the investigation in any manner.
