Learned counsel for respondents No.4 to 7 submits that since the issue involved pertains only to the *inter se* seniority between the petitioners and the private respondents and during the pendency of the present writ petition, petitioners as well as private respondents have retired from service after attaining the age of superannuation, no cause of action survives and the present writ petition may be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Ordered accordingly.

However, since nobody is present on behalf of the petitioners, liberty is granted to them to get the present writ petition revived, if necessity arises.
