By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.124, dated 03.06.2014, registered under Sections 498-A, 406, 383, 120-B IPC, at Police Station Guruharshai, District Ferozepur

The learned counsel for the petitioner states in pursuance of the order dated 08.07.2015 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation. No recovery is to be effected from the petitioner. She is mother in-law and is not named in the FIR.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is not required for

custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 08.07.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
