The petitioner seeks the benefit of regular bail in case FIR No. 11, dated 10.01.2015, under Sections 20/21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, registered at Police Station Sector-5, Panchkula, District Panchkula.

As per prosecution version, the recovery from the present petitioner is of 26 gms. of contraband powder.

It has gone uncontroverted that as per FSL report the salt contained has been found to be Methamphetamine and as per Schedule of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act at Sr. No. 159, quantity above 50 gms. of such contraband has been shown as commercial quantity and in the present case recovery is of 26 gms. which would be construed as non commercial in quantity.

The petitioner was arrested on 10.01.2015. Investigation in the case has already been completed and the challan was presented on 01.04.2015. The trial as such is at the very initial stage.

Even co-accused, namely, Mohit and Parveen have been granted the benefit of regular bail by this Court.

As such without making any observation on merits, petition is allowed. The petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Panchkula.
