The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.235 dated 22.08.2014, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, P.S. Nangal Chaudhary, District Mohindergarh (Haryana).

Learned State counsel submits that fake assurances were statedly given by the petitioner for providing job to unemployed family members of the complainant. Huge amount is stated to have been paid. Appointment in Jaipur Metro as Token Collector was also promised. However, joining was not allowed as appointment letter was found to be fake.

In view of above, no indulgence can be granted. Case requires custodial interrogation.
