Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 CrPC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.9 dated 29.1.2015 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Kiratpur Sahib, District Rupnagar.

This Court vide order dated 22.4.2015 has granted interim bail to the petitioner subject to compliance of provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to order dated 22.4.2015 of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation. He further submits that during the pendency of the present petition, the parties have compromised the matter.

Mr. Navkiran Singh, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and admits the factum of compromise between the parties. He has also no objection in case the interim order dated 22.4.2015 is made absolute.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Surjit Singh does not dispute the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and also submits that his custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

In view of the aforesaid, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 22.4.2015 is made absolute.
