Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.220 dated 02.08.2013, under Sections 419, 420, 465, 466, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Sadar, Jalandhar (**Annexure P-1**).

As per the allegations, one Rajwinder Kaur and the main accused-Baljit Singh are the niece and nephew of Resham Kaur, who was the owner of the land in dispute, qua which a forged unregistered Will dated 17.03.2012 was set up by Baljit Singh and the present petitioner/accused-Charanjit Singh, who was a marginal witness to the same.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the main accused-Baljit Singh has already been granted anticipatory bail by this Court. He further submits that pursuant to the interim directions passed by this Court, vide order dated 27.04.2015, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from HC Avtar Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of the above, interim anticipatory bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 27.04.2015, is made absolute.
