The petitioners are seeking regular bail in FIR No.24 dated 01.02.2015, registered under Sections 307, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC, Police Station Shimlapuri, District Ludhiana.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the injury under Section 307 IPC is attributed to Gurinder Singh @ Guri and Manmeet Singh @ Bani and the petitioners are not named in the FIR and it was 10 days later that the petitioners were named and the allegations against them are that they gave kick blows. He urges that the investigation is over and challan has been filed.

The injury under Section 307 IPC is not attributed to the petitioners. The investigation is over and challan has been filed. The trial will take long to conclude. The petition is allowed and the petitioners are directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court.
