This is a petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure moved by Harpreet Singh @ Happy, feeling apprehension of his arrest, in case FIR No. 47, dated 29.04.2009, under Sections 379, 411, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 473, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Tarn Taran.

2. It is an undisputed fact that petitioner has been facing trial in the above referred case but due to certain circumstances, he could not appear before Id. trial court on March 14, 2014, as a result of his absence, his bail bonds/surety bonds were cancelled. Ultimately, he was declared proclaimed offender.

3. At this juncture, it has been submitted by learned counsel for petitioner that he does not press this petition, in case some direction be given to Id. trial court to dispose of application for bail moved by

petitioner in case he surrender, within some prescribed period.

4. The petition is dismissed as withdrawn and is disposed of as such but with direction to Id. trial court to dispose of application for regular bail, in case, petitioner surrenders before trial court and files an application, within a period of 4 days, from the date of his surrender.
