Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.14 dated 07.02.2015, registered at Police Station Lakhu Ke Behram, District Ferozepur, under Sections 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Vide order dated 22.04.2015, this Court directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner would be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer in connection with

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above-said case FIR.

Learned State counsel after seeking instructions from the investigating officer submits that the petitioner is not cooperating in the investigation and recovery is yet to be effected.

As per the version of complainant, the transaction took place in the month of May, 2011, however, complaint has been made to the police against the petitioner in August, 2014 i.e. almost a gap of three years. The dispute appears to be civil in nature.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 22.04.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute. However, the petitioner will appear before the investigating officer and join the investigation, if required.

Present petition is disposed of accordingly.
