Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.63/15 dated 02.03.2015 under Sections 302, 452, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran.

Notice of motion was issued and interim protection was granted.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Satpal Singh, Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran, submits that in compliance of the order dated 22.04.2015 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for the purpose of any further investigation.

However, learned counsel for the complainant vehemently opposes the present petition contending that cause of death is yet to be ascertained and the petitioner is not entitled for anticipatory bail.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the State, the contentions raised by learned counsel for the complainant have not been found worth acceptance. It is a matter of record that the death took place after 12 days of the occurrence.

In view of the above and without commenting anything further on merits at this stage, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, instant petition is allowed. Order dated 22.04.2015 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute, however, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Disposed of, accordingly.
