The present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') is for quashing of order dated 05.07.2014, passed by the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Fatehgarh Sahib, declaring the petitioner as proclaimed offender.

On the last date of hearing, the petitioner was directed to surrender before the trial Court within one week therefrom and ad interim protection as regards arrest was given subject to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The learned counsel for the petitioner states that in pursuance of order dated 24.04.2015, the petitioner has surrendered

before the trial Court.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, also admits that order dated 24.04.2015, stands complied with.

In view of the same, order dated 24.04.2015 is made absolute.
