Prayer in the present petition filed u/s 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners who have been booked for having committed the offence punishable under Section 306 IPC , in a case arising out of FIR No. 204, dated 26.12.2014, registered at Police Station, Division No.3, District-Jalandhar(Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Head Constable-Prem Lal, Police Station, Division No.3, Jalandhar, very fairly conceded that in compliance of the interim directions issued vide order dated 19.01.2015 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions dated 19.01.2015 passed by this Court, are made absolute.

However, petitioners shall join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
