Learned State counsel on instructions submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 22.04.2015, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Perusal of Annexure P-1 shows that possession of the property had been handed over to the decree holder i.e. Tejinder Singh by the bailiff who had gone to deliver possession with the police help on 22.09.2014. A complaint was lodged subsequently that the articles had been taken in tractor and thrown outside.

Learned counsel for the petitioners pointed out that Bhola is a signatory to the delivery of possession to petitioner No. 1 and false facts have been mentioned in the complaint.

Since the petitioners have joined the investigation, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 22.04.2015 is hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioners will join the investigation as and when required by the police and will not

tamper with evidence or hamper the investigation and will not leave India without permission of the Court and will comply with the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
