The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in FIR No.74 dated 08.08.2014 registered under Sections 306/34 IPC at Police Station Bholath, District Kapurthala.

The petitioner is the wife of the deceased, who was her husband and allegedly forced into suicide on account of conduct of the petitioner in eloping with a fellow villager.

It is stated by learned counsel for the petitioner that six months have elapsed since the day she is in custody, which fact is not controverted by the State counsel. It is contended that possibility of the petitioner being instrumental in causing death of deceased cannot be ruled out.

Be that as it may and without commenting on the merits of the case and noticing that the petitioner is in custody for the last six months and challan has been submitted, the instant petition is accepted. It is directed that the petitioner be released on bail in terms of Section 439 Cr.PC subject to her furnishing of bail bonds to the

satisfaction of learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Kapurthala.

Nothing said herein shall be construed to be an expression
on the merits of the case.
