RAJ MOHAN SINGH J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioners inter alia submits that revision against charge is pending before Additional Sessions Judge, Mohali. The revision could not be taken up due to rush of work on some occasions. On the other hand, trial Court is proceeding in the main case and has reached up to the stage of PWs. Revisional Court is expected to decide the revision petition expeditiously.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass, no reply is necessary.

Accordingly, directions are issued to Additional Sessions Judge, Mohali to decide the pending revision petition as early as possible preferably within one month. Till such time, final order may not be passed by the trial Court.
