Learned counsel for the State after taking instructions from ASI-Darbara Singh, Police Station Chohla Sahib, District Tarn Taran, submits that out of the 15 nominated accused, 11 have been arrested and qua them the investigation is almost complete. He further submits that non-bailable warrants of the remaining four accused have been obtained from the learned Area Judicial Magistrate and the investigating agency is making hectic efforts to

arrest the remaining accused. He further submits that if the persons, who have not been arrested so far, are not arrested then the investigating agency would file the charge-sheet (challan) against the arrested persons in due course.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press this petition, at this stage and prays for withdrawal of the same.

Learned counsel for the respondents have no objection to the above prayer.
