Petitioners, Meenakshi and Rompy Peter, have moved this
Court seeking protection on the ground that they have married on
16.04.2015 against the wishes of their parents and relatives.

Counsel for the petitioners has stated that the petitioners had
moved a representation (Annexure P-5) before the Commissioner of Police,
District Amritsar, to seek protection, but no action has been taken by the
police.

In this view of the matter, Commissioner of Police, District

Amritsar, is directed to look into the representation (Annexure P-5) and if there is any substance in it, may proceed further, in accordance with law.

The present order, however, shall not be deemed to be proof qua the factum/validity of any matrimonial alliance of petitioners.
