SABINA, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for quashing of FIR No.83 dated 25.04.1997, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' for short), registered at Police Station Sadar Pathankot, District Gurdaspur and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise.

Trial Court vide judgment/order dated 28.11.2001 ordered the conviction and sentence of the petitioner under Sections 120-B, 418, 419, 467, 468, 471 read with Section 149 IPC. Appeal filed by the petitioner against his conviction and sentence was dismissed by the Appellate Court vide order dated 22.08.2006. However, sentence qua imprisonment was reduced to one year.

Petitioner filed Crl. Revision No.1793 of 2006 and the same was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 20.08.2014 by reducing the sentence qua imprisonment to six months from one year. Thereafter, petitioner approached the Hon'ble Apex Court and the Special Leave Petition filed by the petitioner, was dismissed.

Since the conviction of the petitioner has been upheld upto the Apex Court, no ground for quashing of the FIR No.83 dated 25.04.1997, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Pathankot, District Gurdaspur, on the basis of compromise, at this stage, is made out.

Dismissed.
