Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for directing the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ambala to decide the stay application filed by the petitioner along with CRR No. 713 of 2013 titled “Mohinder Pal Singh vs. Harjit Kaur and others”.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has filed a revision petition before the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ambala against order dated 24.12.2011 (Annexure P/1) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Ambala.
