Petitioner, by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeks quashing of FIR No.254 dated 16.12.2012 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 406, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 31, Faridabad, District Faridabad, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2)

Notice of motion was issued.

However, learned counsel for respondent No.2 appears and submits that no compromise has taken place between the parties and because of that reason, complainant-respondent No.2 did not appear before the learned trial Court on 11.05.2015 for getting his statement recorded.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks

permission of the Court to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to file fresh one on the same cause of action, as and when parties arrive at compromise.

Permission is granted.

Dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty as prayed for.
