JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

The present petition has been preferred by Manjit Kaur-petitioner, under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of pre-arrest bail, feeling apprehension of her arrest, in the cross-case bearing DDR No.27 dated 27.11.2014, under Sections 452, 323, 308, 427, 34 IPC on the statement of Gurdev Singh in FIR No. 132, dated 26.11.2014, under Sections 452, 323, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Raja Sansi, District Amritsar Rural.

As per the instructions from SI Bikramjeet Singh, learned State counsel has submitted that petitioner has already joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation.

So, taking into consideration all these aspects of the case, order dated April 23, 2015, is made absolute, subject to the following conditions, as envisaged under section 438(2) Cr.P.C:

- (i) that the petitioner shall make herself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;*
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court.*
