This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Sections 406, 498-A IPC at Police Station Women, Ludhiana, vide FIR No.03 dated 03.01.2015.

Learned State counsel (on the instructions from Head Constable Jasbir Singh, who is present in court) submits that pursuant to order dated October 29, 2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.
