Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of the respondent-authorities, petitioner has approached this Court by way of an instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.') with a prayer to issue appropriate directions to the respondent-authorities to ensure meticulous compliance of the provisions of Section 160 Cr.P.C.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned counsel for the State, at the very outset, fairly states that meticulous compliance of provisions of Section 160 Cr.P.C. shall be ensured.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana-respondent No.2 to ensure meticulous compliance of the provisions of Section 160 Cr.P.C. by all the police officers/officials working under his control.

He shall also ensure that the petitioner is not put to an unwarranted harassment by calling her to the police station without ensuring the meticulous compliance of the provisions of Section 160 Cr.P.C.
