This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in a case registered against him vide FIR No.18 dated 17.03.2015 under Sections 379 and 411 IPC and Section 25/54/59 of Arms Act at Police Station City Malout, Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned State counsel has opposed the plea. According to her, on a secret information regarding a gang operating in the State of Punjab who steal the vehicles and sell them outside the State, a naka was laid on March 17, 2015. Co-accused of the petitioner were arrested at the spot. Petitioner, however, fled from the scene of occurrence. A Zen car and a pistol of .32 bore with two cartridges was also recovered. According to learned State counsel, petitioner has already been convicted in a case registered against him under the Narcotic and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

In view of nature of allegations against the petitioner, I am of the considered view that he is not entitled to discretionary relief of pre-arrest bail. Petition is without any merit and is hereby dismissed.
