Report dated 26.11.2015 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Manohar and Rohit as well as of complainant Roji Devi it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.59 dated 20.04.2014 under Sections 406,420 IPC, Police Station, Kurali District SAS Nagar, Mohali and all other consequential

proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.
