MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner alleges that she was married to respondent No.7 who has contracted another marriage and thus prays that appropriate action should be taken against him by accepting this petition. She also prays that she is being criminally intimidated.

For both the aforesaid grievances the petitioner has a remedy of filing a complaint or approaching the court of a Magistrate under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C. The instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is not the appropriate remedy. The petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail herself of alternate remedies under the law.
