Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.85 dated 9.6.2014, under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 474 IPC read with Section 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Phase VIII, SAS Nagar (Mohali).

This Court vide order dated 24.4.2015, while issuing notice of motion, had granted interim bail to the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Shamsheer Singh, has stated that in terms of the above order the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 24.4.2015 are made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
