JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No.25, dated 17.01.2014, under Sections 323, 341, 506 and 497 IPC, registered at Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar (Mohali) along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-1).

2. Report of Id. Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that parties have compromised the matter without any pressure, coercion or undue influence. The same is genuine and outcome of free consent of the parties. Even otherwise, the matter involved is personal in nature,

which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No.25, dated 17.01.2014, under Sections 323, 341, 506 and 497 IPC, registered at Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar (Mohali) and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioner.
