Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking quashing of F.I.R No.198 dated 13.12.2008 under sections 279, 337, 338, 427 I.P.C (subsequently section 304-A I.P.C was added) registered at Police Station, Tanda, District Hoshiarpur, on the basis of compromise, which as per counsel has been entered into between the parties.

Counsel for the petitioner having argued the matter at some length, prays for withdrawal of the instant petition.

Prayer is allowed.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

It is, however, observed that dismissal of the instant petition as withdrawn would not preclude the petitioner from raising all pleas in defence as may be available to him strictly in accordance with law during the trial proceedings.
