FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in FIR No.100 dated 27.09.2014 under Sections 307,309,506, 120-B IPC and Sections 25,54,59 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Cheema, District Sangrur.

The allegation against the petitioner-Janak Raj is that he was instrumental in procuring pistol .32 by which weapon the principal accused Gagandeep Singh had fired at complainant Mahant Ram Dass over objection as the complainant was conducting black magic in the village.

It is *inter alia* contended on behalf of the petitioner that the principal accused Gagandeep Singh has since been allowed bail by this Court and that no role is attributed to the present petitioner in the commission of this actual offence and is in custody since 6.10.2014 and that the parties are since entered

into a compromise regarding which the petition is already filed in this Court which fact is not objected by the learned State counsel.

In view thereof and keeping in view the principle of parity, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition for grant of regular bail is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
