Petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.9 dated 24.01.2014 under Sections 304-A/279/337/338/427 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Moga, District Moga at the instance of respondent No.2 on the basis of compromise.

Since challan has been presented and charges are framed, I do not find any ground to quash the FIR under Section 304-A IPC on the basis of compromise as the dictum is already there.

Petition is dismissed but it is ordered that it will be open to petitioner to seek acquittal on appreciation of evidence in case the prosecution witnesses do not support the case of the prosecution. The factum of compromise may be taken into consideration as the mitigant circumstances to grant any other relief during the course of trial including the benefit of doubt.

The accused would be required to appear before the trial Court to face further proceedings on 20.03.2015, the date fixed there.
