Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to petitioner No.2 in case FIR No. 23 dated 04.02.2014, under Sections 324, 323, 341, 148, 149 IPC and 27, 54, 59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Jalalabad, District Fazilka.

It is pertinent to mention that petition qua petitioner No.1 has been dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 23.04.2015.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Vide order dated 23.04.2015, this Court directed that in the

event of arrest, petitioner No.2-Puran Singh would be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer in connection with above-said case FIR.

On instructions from the investigating officer, learned State counsel informs that petitioner No.2 has joined the investigation. Learned State counsel further states that nothing is to be recovered from petitioner No.2 and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 23.04.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Present petition is disposed of accordingly.
