JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 130, dated 21.11.2012, under Sections 326, 323, 452 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Kamboh, District Amritsar (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-4).

2. Report of Id. Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that parties have compromised the matter with their free will and full senses, volition of the parties, without any fear, apprehension, undue influence or

coercion. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 130, dated 21.11.2012, under Sections 326, 323, 452 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Kamboh, District Amritsar and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed qua petitioners.
