Petitioner, by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeks direction to the official respondents for protecting his life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No. 3 to 8.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 7.4.2015 passed by this Court in CRM-M-10632 of 2015 filed by the petitioner, he approached the Deputy Inspector General of Police, Panchkula-respondent No.2 by moving a self contained representation dated 8.4.2015 (Annexure P-4) but no action thereon has been taken so far. He further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent No.2 is directed to consider and decide his representation, within a reasonable time.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, the Deputy Inspector General of Police, Panchkula-respondent No.2 is directed to look into the matter, consider the grievance of the petitioner, raised vide his representation dated 8.4.2015 (Annexure P-4) and decide the same, at an early date by passing an appropriate order thereon, in accordance with law, but in any case within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of the order.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present petition stands disposed of.
