Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to the official respondents not to harass the petitioners at the instance of private respondent nos. 5 to 10.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that petitioners have married with their own free will on 08.12.2013 and have been residing together. They are having one male child from their wedlock. The petitioners are being attacked by private respondents. They have already moved application dated 13.04.2015 (Annexure P/6) to respondent no.4 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Faridkot, but till date, no action has been taken thereon. Learned counsel for the petitioners further contends that direction be issued to respondent no.4 to take appropriate action on the

application (Annexure P/6).

In view of this, respondent no.4 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Faridkot, is directed to take a decision on the application (Annexure P/6) in accordance with law. If the petitioners need protection, they may be provided accordingly.

Disposed of in the above terms.
