This is an application filed on behalf of the appellant

is allowed and the main appeal is taken up today.

**MAIN CASE**

The respondents-Charan Singh, Devinder, Shivraj  
Singh, Anita,Naresh, Rakesh, Sunita, Kamlesh, Rajwati, Mahesh

Singh, Hukum Singh through Special Power of Attorney, Mahesh Singh and Rameshwari are present in person and have been identified by their counsel and Khemchand, Advocate. The photocopy of their Identity Cards have also been filed in the Court along with their affidavits.

The matter is stated to have been compromised. The Compromise Deed is Exhibit-CX. The amount has been paid to the respondents by way of demand draft mentioned in the Compromise Deed.

The appeal stands decided in view of the Compromise Deed Exhibit-CX. So, in these circumstances, the appeal is accepted and the judgment of the appellate Court dated 08.05.1990 stands set-aside and the suit of the plaintiffs stands dismissed in view of the compromise. The parties are left to bear their own cost.
