Report dated 04.08.2015 sent by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Moga has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Parminder Kaur @ Dimple and Kulwinder Kaur as well as of complainant Balwinder Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is a dispute over employment and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and to bring about harmonious atmosphere and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.25 dated 01.03.2014 under Sections

420,465,468,471 IPC, Police Station, Sadar Moga, District Moga and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.
