The instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed by the petitioner for issuance a direction to respondents No. 1 and 2 to protect the life, liberty and property of petitioner at the hands of respondent No. 3 as he is harassing and blackmailing the petitioner and his family members by giving threats to implicate the petitioner in a false case.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that father of the petitioner, namely; Mohan Singh holds a valid licence for selling '*Bhaang*' in milk since 01.10.1944 but the local police is giving threats to the petitioner to implicate him in a false case.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Gazi Mohd., DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper-book be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

In view of the nature of order that is proposed to be passed, no reply is required to be filed by the respondents. The petitioner had already filed a representation dated 27.03.2015 (Annexure P-1) before respondent No. 2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, in this regard.

The instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to look into the allegations contained in representation dated 27.03.2015 (Annexure P-1) and take appropriate steps, if required, in accordance with law.
