Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner during the trial of case FIR No.16 dated 21.01.2015, under Sections 363, 366-A, IPC, registered at Police Station Gate Hakima, District Amritsar City.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is in custody since 21.01.2015 and moreover, during the pendency of the present petition, the matter has been compromised between the parties vide compromise deed dated 30.03.2015 (Annexure P/2).

Mr.Manoj K.Sharma, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and does not dispute that the matter has

been resolved between the parties and a separate petition bearing CRM-M-12800 of 2015 for quashing of the FIR, has been filed.

In view of the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted to regular bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial court, Amritsar.
