By filing the present petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought extension of regular bail in case FIR No.198, dated 08.06.2014, registered under Sections 498-A, 304-B, 306 and 201 IPC, at Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Vide order dated 27.01.2015, the petitioner was granted interim bail for his treatment. In pursuance of order dated 19.05.2015, the learned State counsel has obtained the opinion of the treating doctor, namely Dr. Nidhi Bhardwaj of the Govt. Medical College and Hospital, Sector 32, Chandigarh. As per the report/opinion which is prepared after discussion with Professor

Ram Singh and Prof. S.S Lehl, the petitioner requires hospitalization for glycaemic control and evaluation for incontinence.

The opinion/report received from the treating doctor of Govt. Medical College and Hospital, Sector 32, Chandigarh filed by learned State counsel is taken on record as Mark-A.

Keeping in view the opinion/report Mark-A prepared by the treating doctor, the present petition is disposed of and the order dated 27.01.2015 is further extended to another four months. The petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing fresh requisite bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court on the same terms and conditions. The date to surrender is to be indicated by the releasing Court.
