Both the petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major and seek protection as they apprehend danger from respondents no.4 & 5.

Petitioner no.1 is Hindu lady who was earlier married to respondent no.4 and has not filed any document of divorce. There is a plea that petitioner no.1 converted to Muslim and then married with petitioner no.2.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioners to approach respondent no.2 i.e. Superintendent of Police, Mewat and present their representation. On doing

so, respondent no.2 would be obligated to look into the grievance and take steps he deems fit strictly in accordance with law.

Petition stands disposed of.
