The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.61, dated 1.6.2014, registered under Sections 15/61/85 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Nathana, District Bathinda.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the recovery is of 60 kgs of poppy husk from four people and there is no other case pending against him and that he has now been in custody since 1.6.2014.

Counsel for the respondent, on instructions from ASI Gurbinder Singh, has accepted the factual assertions.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I deem it

appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of.
