The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.117 dated 21.11.2014 under Sections 306, 34 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Mulepur, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

Deceased is Gurpreet Kaur i.e. wife of the present petitioner and who is stated to have committed suicide on 21.11.2014 by jumping into the Bhakra Canal.

F.I.R was registered on the statement Harbans Singh i.e. father of deceased. Allegations are with regard to the present petitioner maintaining illicit relationship with one Pinder Kaur.

Petitioner has been in custody since 5.12.2014.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from Inspector Karam Chand would apprise the Court that investigation in the case has been completed and the challan has been presented on 2.2.2015. The trial, as such, is at the very initial stage and would take some time to conclude.

The issue as regards the illicit relationship even if found to be true would amount to abetment to suicide so as to fall within the mischief of offence under section 306 I.P.C, would be a moot question to be considered during the course of trial.

In the totality of circumstances noticed herein above, the petitioner is held entitled to the concession of bail. Petition, accordingly, is allowed.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of C.J.M.,
Fatehgarh Sahib.
