Instant petition has been preferred under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 169 dated October 13, 2007 under Sections 148, 307, 367, 326, 325, 324, 323 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Mehta, District Amritsar.

2. Undisputably on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-3), appeal i.e. CRA No. S-1772-SB of 2010 filed by co-accused of petitioner namely, Jarmanjit Singh, Darshan Singh, Dial Singh, Paramjit Kaur and Dalbir Kaur was decided on February 15, 2013 whereby, sentence imposed upon them by learned trial Court was reduced to the period already undergone.

3. Learned counsel for the complainant has also submitted that a compromise (Annexure P-3) arrived at between the parties and has further submitted that he has no objection in case instant petition is disposed of.

4. Keeping in view compromise arrived at between the parties and the fact that petitioner is behind the bars since November 11, 2014, instant petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.
